- 1. The presiding officer of the House is the Speaker of the House. <u>Article I, Section 2, Clause 5</u>
- 2. Congress has the power to declare war.
- 3. Congress cannot grant titles of nobility.
- 4. A representative must be a citizen for seven years, twenty-five years old, and live in the state.
- 5. Congress has the power to establish post offices.
- 6. All revenue bills must originate in the House of Representatives.
- 7. The Vice President is the presiding officer of the Senate.
- 8. No state can make a treaty with a foreign country.
- 9. The governor has the authority to call an election to fill a vacancy in the House of Representatives.
- 10. Expulsion can be used to remove a member of either house of Congress for an infraction of the rules.
- 11. Congressmen are paid a salary out of the Treasury of the United States.
- 12. A term in the Senate is six years for each senator.
- 13. Congress has the power to establish a uniform rule of naturalization.
- 14. All bills must be passed by the House and the Senate, and presented to the President.
- 15. A person convicted by the impeachment process can still be tried in a regular court if he or she violated a law of the United States.
- 16. Congress has the power to borrow money on the credit of the United States.
- 17. Congress has the power to make all laws which are necessary and proper to execute all other powers. (Elastic Clause)
